

Enclosed are two letters (Show Me The Buyer, 2010 November 14) (Prosecute For Fraud, 2010 December 4) and two spreadsheets () () that summarize and illustrate some of the problems of financing local government services with a tax on landed property and improvements.

I'm a white (non-Hispanic) (non-Catholic) (non-immigrant) divorced female who has lived in Chicago's () ward/ () neighborhood continuously for 35 years. The tax history on my property indicates that people with access to the Cook County Assessor's database have tampered with the legal description and/or valuations of my property and neighboring properties - during or after massive 'white flight' from the neighborhood in the 1980s and 1990s. The purpose of the tampering seems to be to force a low-income white resident out of her home by over-taxing her property. And while she remains in her home, to force her to subsidize city services to under-taxed Hispanic properties. My life experiences indicate that most of the services are provided by incompetent or corrupt workers who function like a gang and operate to the detriment of the community. The tamperer(s) might be one or more relatives and staffers of the Berrios family acting in collusion with relatives and staffers of the () family, who have neighboring offices on Fullerton Avenue 4500-4600 west in Chicago. I'm an eyewitness and photographer of the fact that Puerto Ricans with city and county jobs have been instrumental in forcing white flight, protecting other aggressive Hispanics, and encouraging white-on-white aggression for political and financial gain. Documents that support my allegations are online at public and password-protected sites.
